Borrow Library Books with Your Android-Powered Device

Borrowing eBooks to read on your Android-powered device (including tablets and smart phones) is simple. First, you'll download the app from the Market. Then, you'll choose eBooks from the collection, check them out and download them. Before you begin, make sure you have your library card, because you'll need your account number.

1. Open the Market on your device.
2. Open the "Search" button (may look like a magnifying glass) and type in "OverDrive." Select the OverDrive Media Console and select "Download."
3. Once the app downloads, open the app.
4. Find the button that says "Get Books." Note: you may need to select the menu button.
5. Select "Add a Library." Choose your library by postal code, name or location. For Seymour Library, enter the postal code 13021 and select "Search." Now select "Auburn" and then "Finger Lakes Library System." This will bring you to the mobile digital downloads page.
6. Browse for a book either by the "Browse" button, the "Search" button, or the featured titles on the main page.
7. Once you've chosen a title, select it to open the book profile, and then choose "Add to My Download Cart." If you are finished, select "Proceed to check out," then "Confirm check out," and finally "Download."

Please Note: You will be asked to enter your library number (d2025...) and PIN (usually the last four digits of your phone number) before checking out. If you choose to save this information, you will not need to re-enter it during later uses.

8. Your title should appear on your OverDrive book shelf. Select the "Download" button to finish downloading the book onto the device if necessary.

To Return Your eBook

1. Open the OverDrive App.
2. Tap and hold the item you would like to return.
3. A pop-up screen should appear and give you the option to Return and Delete the Book.

Please note: The mobile devices all require an Adobe account. Your device should allow you to register right from the device.

Also: Mobile devices can also borrow books through the Kindle App. Simply follow the instructions for borrowing eBooks with a Kindle.
