

## Borrow library books with your Kindle

## KINDLE

Borrowing eBooks to read on your Kindle is simple. First, you'll choose eBooks from the collection, check them out and download them. Next, you'll select your Kindle device. Finally, you'll sync your device. Before you begin, make sure you have registered your Kindle with Amazon and you have your library card, because you'll need your account number.

1. Visit our web site: [www.seymourlibrary.org](http://www.seymourlibrary.org) . Look in the right column, under the heading "Library links," and click the "Digital downloads" link.
2. Search for book titles or authors using the search bar. Please note: only books with a Kindle icon are available for Kindle.
3. Choose your book and click "Add to My Download Cart."
4. Click on "Proceed to Checkout." Enter your library card number (including the D) with no spaces. Enter your four digit PIN. Select a loan period from the drop down list (7, 14 or 21 days) and click on "Confirm Checkout."
5. Click on "Get for Kindle." This will redirect you to the Amazon.com web site.
6. Once the page has loaded, select your Kindle and click on the "Get Library Book" link. Your book should now be ready to sync either wirelessly or with your USB cord.
7. If your device downloads wirelessly, your eBook should appear on your Kindle's home screen. If your device is wireless but the eBook is not displayed, you can download it through "Archived Items." Select "Archived Items" from the Home screen or "View Archived Items" from the menu. Select your eBook from the Archived Items screen.
8. To sync your eBook through a USB connection, connect your Kindle to your computer using your USB cable. Type "[amazon.com/manageyourkindle](http://amazon.com/manageyourkindle)" into your computer's browser, locate the eBook from your Kindle Library list, click the "Actions" button to the right, and select "Download & transfer via USB."
9. Choose your Kindle from the "Which Kindle will you transfer this to?" dropdown menu. If you are prompted to either "Save" or "Open" the file, choose "Save," and save it to an easy to remember location on your computer, such as the Desktop.
10. Open the Kindle drive, located in the "My Computer" or "Computer" menu for Windows or on the Desktop for Macs. There will be several folders inside the drive; one will be labeled "Documents." Move your downloaded eBook into this folder, by clicking on the file and dragging it into the folder.
11. Eject your Kindle and disconnect the USB cable from your computer and Kindle. Your downloaded material should now appear on your Kindle's home screen.

Please note: With the new Kindle Fire you can browse, check out, and download your library eBook all from the device.
